

A quality education should be something every single person can access. In my own life, I've realized that everything I've achieved is because of the educational opportunities I've had.

I served on the Board of Meritus College Fund, which merged with 10,000 Degrees in 2018. It has been a joy to see the merger make both stronger. Former Meritus students, staff, and donors are now blessed to be part of a larger, more diverse 10,000 Degrees community, poised to continue to grow and expand our impact.

I'm so excited that 10,000 Degrees launched programs in East San Jose last year! The need for college success and attainment support is enormous in the South Bay. Only 10,000 Degrees is providing a community college success program here.

Similar to the South Bay, there are no organizations like 10,000 Degrees in Utah. When the Utah Jazz NBA basketball team announced one full college scholarship for every win, I knew 10,000 Degrees would be a great partner! Through our connections to the team ownership, we introduced the Jazz to 10,000 Degrees. In the pandemic, 10,000 Degrees had learned how to successfully support students remotely. Now, we are supporting the first 30 students in Utah colleges!

Going to college was never not an option even though I was a first-generation college student. Education was very important in my family.

My parents were - and are still - my biggest cheerleaders. Going through the college process, there were a lot of questions I had. I wasn't aware of the resources out there that could help.

It wasn't until my third graduate degree that I realized all the resources that I had missed out on that could have helped me—with my own learning and financially. For me, this really highlights the need for supporting students in the way that we do at 10,000 Degrees. I hope that helping students access these resources makes their journeys easier than mine.

The root of education is that we should all be lifelong learners, not just from books but from other people as well.

Education helps shape who we are and how we can leave a legacy in our communities. It's how we learn and how we grow.

There were a lot of mistakes in my college journey that happened along the way. I'm proud that I didn't bend and fall to external pressures. I trusted the process that I knew nothing about, because I allowed myself to be led by my passion.

I tell everybody about how passionate our staff is and how great it is to work alongside people who look

forward to coming to work every day. It's unique and I don't take that for granted. The whole staff is passionate about what we do, and I think that's really important and something that makes 10,000 Degrees special.

My parents gave up a lot to move to the US. In Mexico, I never felt that we were missing anything, so as a child it was difficult to understand why we moved. When I started talking about college, I didn't think college was going to be an option for me.

My father said we moved to the United States for a better life, a comment that stayed with me when I started investigating colleges. "Dad, when you moved us to the USA, you said it was for a better life. An education was going to give us that better life."

Education has provided me not just a better life for myself, but also for my family. I am one of ten siblings and the first to graduate from college. Through my hard work and focus, I set an example for the rest of the family. Today, I have younger family members with college degrees and holding important jobs.

If students are able to access 10,000 Degrees and stay with it, as a high school principal, this is one of the greatest gifts I can give to graduating seniors.

I want to be able to give back to students and to families. Sometimes you don't know the systems and you don't know the process. With 10,000 Degrees, you have a guiding angel there to support you.



I attribute my life to my parents' sacrifices, but also to my education. Because education is the way the cycle of poverty can be broken.

When I finished school and started working in financial services, my passions for business and giving back to my community came together.

After I was introduced to 10,000 Degrees, I knew I wanted to build a work-partnership and started a pilot program to provide internships and access to opportunities for 10,000 Degrees students. Today, 10,000 Degrees is an official internship partner!

We also piloted a career mentoring program to help align our work with scholars' career needs. 30 colleagues and 30 students from 10,000 Degrees were matched to help facilitate meaningful connections, and help the students succeed in their careers. After completing our first successful year, we are now working with 10,000 Degrees to broaden this program outside of work and make it more accessible to more scholars.

I really believe in the scholars — they are amazing. I'm always so inspired by them and their potential. I'm excited to be part of 10,000 Degrees and continue to make positive changes in my community. Thank you for the opportunity.

I grew up in a single-parent household. I'm the third out of six siblings. I really looked up to my older siblings, but I also knew that I didn't want to have their same challenges in life.



The best piece of advice I can give current college students is to trust your instincts and never give up. First-gen, low-income students often don't have someone to look up to and that can be challenging. Don't ever feel like you're unimportant or invalid. At the end of the day, we're all achieving the same goal.

I've seen the inequity in education, especially in Marin. I felt there was a need for help and was inspired by the 10,000 Degrees students and staff to help close that gap.

I work at an investment company called Loomis Sayles and I knew I wanted to hire 10,000 Degrees students. I recommended a partnership between Loomis and 10,000 Degrees to hire interns every year – we now have our first 10,000 Degrees alumna full-time hire!

Through the 10,000 Degrees Academic Support program, I've also been tutoring women in advanced-level math. I love working with women who either love math or may not really like math, but I help them to see that they can do it – and help them to overcome these barriers.

As I've gotten to know the 10,000 Degrees students, both as an Academic Support tutor and as a manager of several interns at Loomis, I've seen how much 10,000 Degrees can do for students. Many didn't even know there was a path to college. But 10,000 Degrees guides them on this path, and stays with them through their whole college journey.
